HIRTA - Demand Response Public Transit Service Action Plan Available for Public Review

AMES, Iowa – The draft Demand Response Public Transit Service Action Plan for Story County is available for public comment through Friday, Jan. 9, 2015. This document is designed to assist and provide direction for improvements in the efficiency and effectiveness of HIRTA services as well as other public transportation options within Story County that do not operate on a fixed route like CyRide. The City of Ames and Story County are seeking to identify gaps or solutions that could be considered as the plan is finalized through the public comment period.

Copies of the plan are available for review Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. in the City Manager's Office at Ames City Hall, 515 Clark Ave. To review the draft plan online, go to www.cityofames.org.
